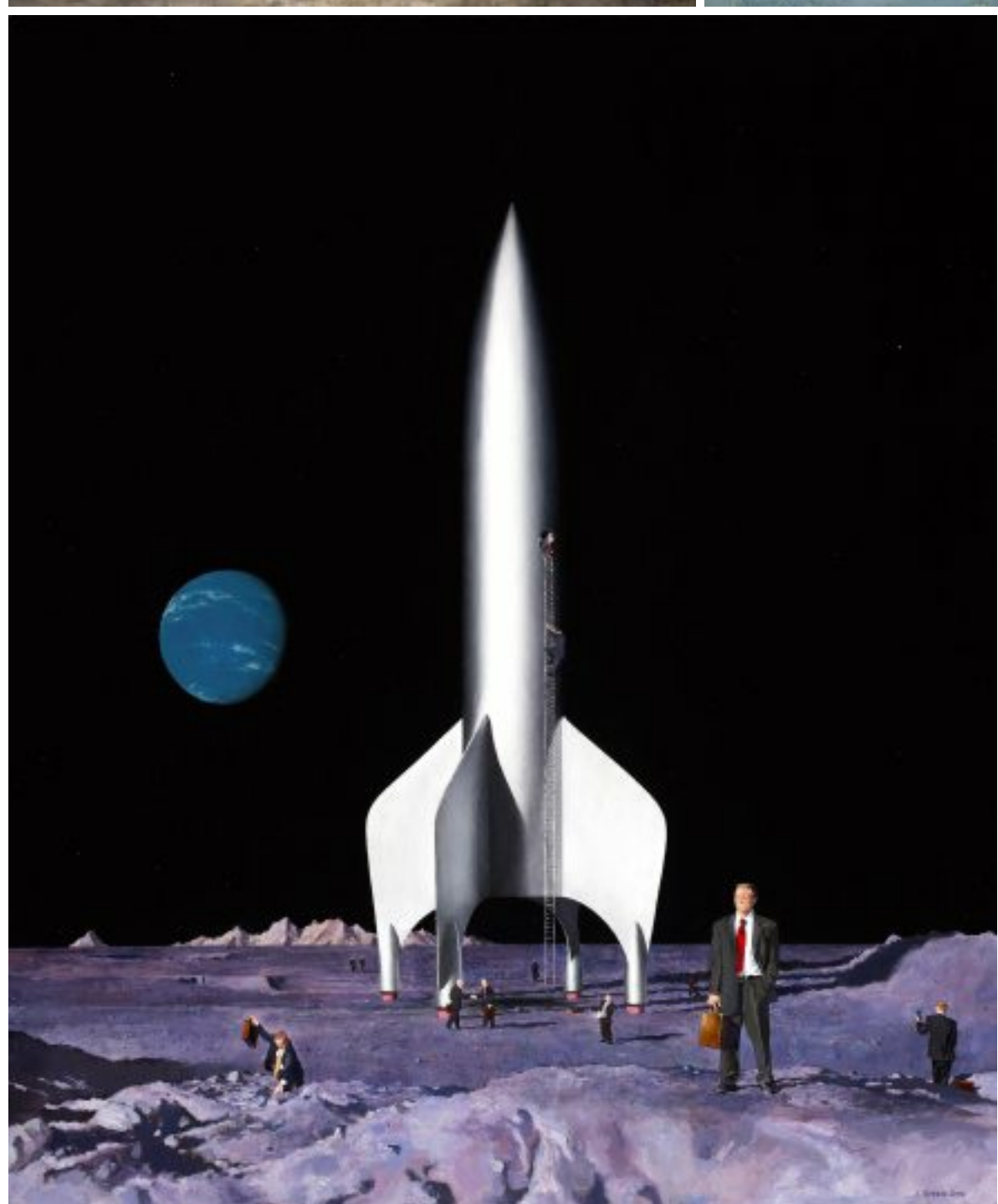

Statement

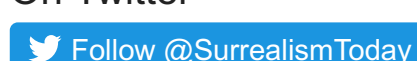

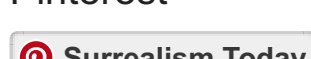
