Please read the [relevant documentation](#) in full. Devuan Daedalus can be installed as an upgrade from Devuan Chimaera or migrated from Debian Bookworm. Note that skipping releases is not supported.

Debian is proceeding with a full implementation of the merged usr file structure during this current testing cycle. In order to focus Devuan's available resources on our primary purpose regarding systemd, Devuan developers have decided it is in the project's best interest to implement the usrmerge.
