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Verb-object compound, composed of *pela* (“to skin”) + *gatos* (“cats”).

- IPA^(key): /pelaˈgatos/ [pe.laˈɣa.ɾos]
- Rhymes: **-atos**
- Syllabification: pe·la·ga·tos

pelagatos *m* (plural **pelagatos**)

- nobody** (unimportant **person**) [synonyms ▲]

Synonyms: **pelagallos**, **don nadie**, **pintamonas**
