

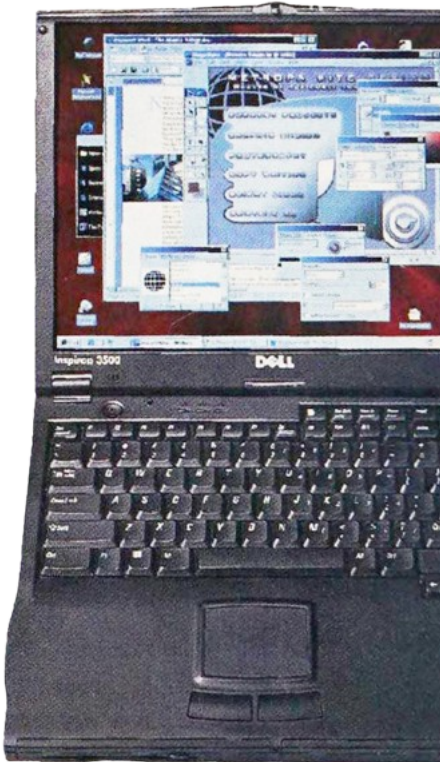
Dell Inspiron 3500
